### CAREERS

community. This program is geared toward those who see teaching the Bible as their primary ministry. Possible careers include ministry leadership, chaplaincy, missions, education, research, and more!

### ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

The application packet consists of an application, pastor's reference form, a Residence Hall Application, and a Health Form to be completed by a physician. Documentation for assessment of a student's English proficiency is also required, including AP English, SAT or ACT scores. Documentation of official high school and/or college transcripts will be needed to process an application.

### SCHEDULE

Traditional on-campus programs run on a Fall/Spring semester schedule.

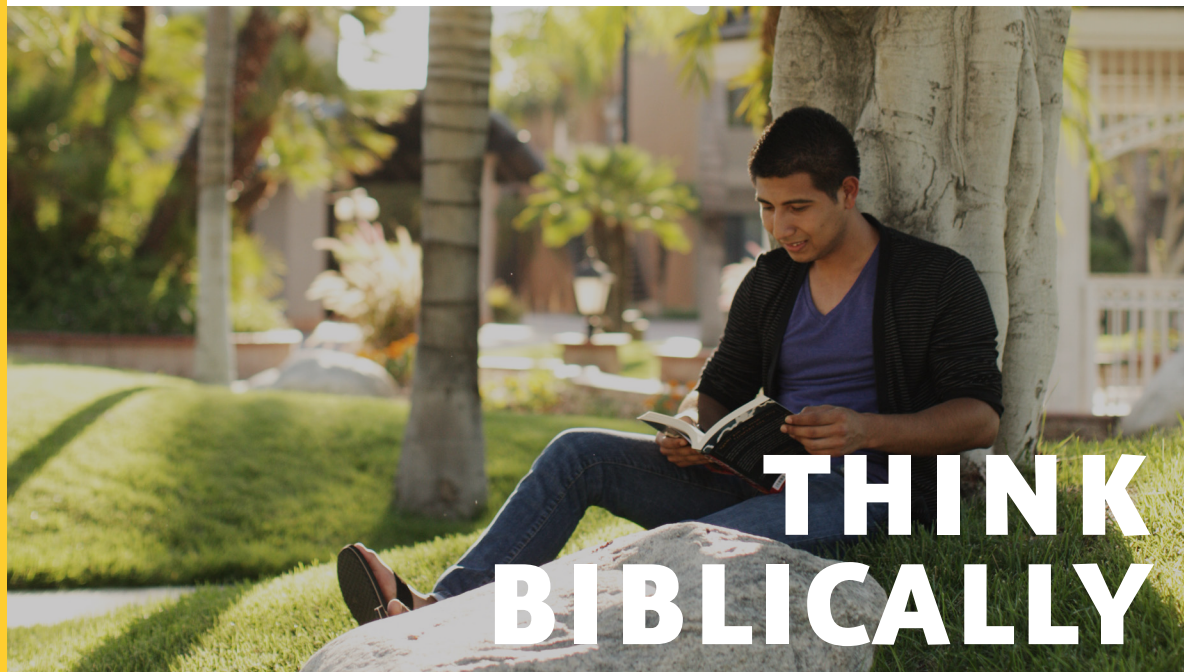
