



Transfer Guidelines for Life Pacific College

The following information is given to assist you in understanding how courses may transfer and apply to an undergraduate degree at Life Pacific College. This information is a guide and does not guarantee transferability of any specific course. Please review the LPC catalog and course descriptions before choosing a transfer course. Then review your institution's catalog to find a comparable course.

LPC Requirement	LPC Units	Transfer Requirements
English Composition & Research	3	Must include a research paper and is often a first or second semester course. <i>Applicable to: AAGS, AABS, BABS, BATM, BABA, BAHDP, BAWAM</i>
Speech & Presentation	3	Public Speaking – must include delivery of speeches. Interpersonal or Small Group Communication will not meet this requirement. <i>Applicable to: AAGS, AABS, BABS, BATM, BABA, BAHDP, BAWAM</i>
Math Elective	3	Math, including business math, college algebra, statistics, accounting, or economics <i>Applicable to: AAGS, BABS, BATM, BABA, BAWAM (BABA and BAHDP require Statistics)</i>
Lab Science Elective	4	Lecture and lab component required. <i>Applicable to: AAGS, AABS, BABS, BATM, BABA, BAHDP, BAWAM</i>
Humanities Elective	3	Music, Art, Language, Philosophy, Drama/Theatre <i>Applicable to: AAGS, BABS, BATM, BABA, BAHDP (BAWAM Must have Music Theory I)</i>
Literature Elective	3	Literature including courses about specific genres, authors, periods, or poetry <i>Applicable to: AAGS, AABS, BABS, BATM, BABA, BAHDP (BAWAM must have Intro to Dramatic Lit)</i>
Social & Behavioral Science Elective	3	Anthropology, Geography, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology <i>Note: Psychology or Sociology is REQUIRED for BATM, BAHDP requires both.</i> <i>Applicable to: AAGS, AABS, BABS, BATM, BABA, BAHDP, BAWAM</i>
History Elective	3	Most common include US History or World History. Any applicable History Course will transfer. <i>Applicable to: AAGS, BABS, BATM, BABA, BAHDP (BAWAM Must have History of the Worship Arts)</i>
Bible/Theology Electives	0-6	Generally transferred from a Christian institution. Courses related to the Bible or doctrine. <i>Applicable to: AABS (3 units), BABS (6 units), BABA (12 units), BAHDP (12 units)</i>
Ministry Electives	0-9	Must be transferred from a Christian institution. <i>Applicable to: BABS (6 units), BATM (9 units), Not Required for BABA, BAHDP, BAWAM</i>
Open Electives	0-18	Any college-level course not applicable to a specific degree requirement. <i>Applicable to: BABS (18 units), BATM (14 units), BABA (14 units), BAHDP (13 units), BAWAM (13)</i>

LPC Transfer Policies

- Classes are transferred on a course-by-course basis.
- Credit is given to courses taken at another institution that match our basic content and emphasis.
- Courses must have at least half the credit of our equivalent course in order to fulfill the specific LPC course requirement.
- All quarter units will be converted to semester units. LPC grants 2 semester units for every 3 quarter units.
- Students must complete transfer work with a C- or better. Grades are transferred from accredited institutions.
- All courses must be college-level. Remedial courses will not be transferred.
- Credits from some recognized but non-accredited schools will transfer. In this case, transcripts are evaluated at the time of your acceptance to LPC, but the credit is not transferred until you have completed 24 units of study at an accredited institution with a minimum GPA of 2.0.
